



The 2022 William Schatzkamer Young Artists' Competition

We are delighted to have young talent interested in our competition. We think it is a terrific experience for a serious young artist and we welcome your participation. Please read the rules that we have established and then submit your application.

RULES FOR ENTRY

1. Instrumentalists must be between the ages of 13 and 22 inclusive, vocalists between the ages of 16 through 26 inclusive. Applicants must play classical instruments or be classical vocalists, and perform music composed with orchestral accompaniment from the accepted classical repertoire (one movement for instrumentalists, two selections for vocalists). Total performance time should be approximately 10 minutes. Previous winners of the competition are not eligible to compete again for three years.
2. Due to the recent resurgence of COVID, our initial auditions will be virtual (video). Applicants should perform their selections from memory and provide their own accompanist for the video. Applicants should upload a copy of their selection to the [Dropbox](#) for the judges.
3. After review of the video submissions, judges will choose the top 5 for an in-person "play-off", which will be held on Sunday, March 20, 2022 at the Steinway Piano Gallery, 12033 Dorsett Rd., Maryland Heights, MO 63043. The judges will base their decision solely on artistic merit. The judges will choose 2 winners from the "play-off." **Live events subject to change due to COVID.**
4. Winner(s) will perform in concert with the University City Symphony Orchestra on **Sunday, May 15, 2022**, at 3:00 pm at *Washington University's 560 Building*. The winner must be available to perform and rehearse: failure to adhere to this will result in forfeiting award and performance. All applicants grant to UCSO the rights to use their name, performance and likeness online and in promotional materials as determined by UCSO, and a recording will be made of the performance, which guest artists may use as an audition piece if they wish. Winners will receive a cash scholarship, the amount of which will be determined by the donor.
5. *Audition videos should be recent (within the last 6 months) and must be submitted via [Dropbox](#) by February 20, 2022.* All contestants will be notified of the initial competition outcome by email no later than March 1, 2022, and finalists will be notified of playoff results by March 27, 2022. The judges' comments on your performance will also be forwarded.
6. Entry fee is \$40.00.
7. Complete application packets, with video and entry fee, must be received by **February 20, 2022**. *Late registrations will be accepted at the discretion of the judges and will be charged a \$10.00 late fee.* Fill out the online form below or print out the application form, complete it, and mail it with your payment to the Orchestra mailing address as it appears on this stationary with a check made payable to the University City Symphony Orchestra.
